

Letter from A.P. Watt to S.R. Crockett

8 December 1905

My dear Crockett

Having offered the American book rights of Fishers of Men unsuccessfully to several American publishers I recently approached Messrs Appleton and as a result of my negotiations with them, I now have the pleasure of informing you that they have agreed to purchase the US book rights and to pay us for these rights the usual royalty of 15% and on publication a sum equal to the royalties on all the copies sold on subscription, ie before and up to the date of publication.
