Dear Sir,

Referring to your call here this afternoon when you left with me the letter from Mr Clarence McClraine to yourself, asking on behalf of Messrs. Harper Brothers the name of the artist who will illustrate Mr. Crockett's story, and what will be the size of the illustrations. I write to say that it is impossible to decide either of these questions at the present time, as you will bear in mind that it will not be published until the year 1896. I hope it may answer Messrs. Harper Brothers' purpose to leave the matter in our hands as they have hitherto done, and let us decide after reading the story who shall illustrate it and what size the illustrations should be.
