

Letter from The Copp, Clark Company Limited to A.P. Watt & Son
Toronto

London July 2nd 1903

Gentlemen,

We have decided to purchase from you the Canadian rights of the two new novels by S.R. Crockett, on the terms discussed with you by our Mr. Copp when recently in London. One of these books we understand is a novel of adventure which will be published serially in the British Weekly, and will be published in book form probably in the spring of 1905. The other entitled "May Margaret" will be a serial in the Graphic and will probably be published in book form in the autumn of 1905.

The terms as discussed were that we were to pay you on copies sold a royalty of 20% on the retail price (\$1.50) of the cloth edition and a royalty of 16 2/3% on the retail price (75cents) of the paper edition. We to make you an advance payment of £100 upon account of royalty upon publication of each book.
