

Letter from L.H. Bliss to A.P. Watt

London,  
January 5th 1898

A.P. Watt Esq.

Dear Mr. Watt,

I find I have over bound "Lads Love" 6/- and have got over 2,000 in stock.

By the terms of the agreement, unless I sell these at less than 1/6d I should have to pay royalty at the published price. I think however I might be able to sell them to the Colonies at 1/10 or even 2/-, and I shall be glad to know if I might be allowed to do this and yet pay upon the nett receipts. I should not in this case make any more than I make upon the Cloth Colonials at 1/8d.

Trusting that you may be able to grant me this permission.

p.s. I will of course guarantee not to sell them in Great Britain - I understand of course that if I sell in Great Britain it must be at less than 1/6d, if the royalty is to be on the net receipts.
